### **Declaration of Consent to Data Processing**

Moog Rekofa GmbH is pleased about your visit to our website and your interest in the company.

We take the protection of your personal data seriously and want you to feel safe and comfortable when visiting our website.

When visiting our website we do not necessarily demand personal data. (For example name, address or e-mail contact). We will only demand personal data if you want to provide us with the data as, for example, in the case of contacting us. Personal data are always based on a voluntary basis and will not be disclosed to third parties without consent.

We point out that the transmission of data on the Internet (for example in the case of communication by e-mail) can have security gaps.

A complete protection of the data from access by third parties is not possible.

The use of contact data published by third parties in the context of the imprint obligation for the purpose of sending unsolicited advertising and information materials is hereby expressly excluded.

The operators of the pages expressly reserve the right to take legal action in the event of unsolicited promotional information, such as spam mails.

All personal data will be collected, processed and used in accordance with the respective applicable regulations for the protection of personal data.

## **Cookies**

The websites of Moog Rekofa GmbH use cookies. Cookies are text files which are stored on a computer system via an Internet browser.

The use of cookies makes it possible for visited websites and servers to distinguish the individual browser of the person concerned from others.

By using cookies, the company can increase the user-friendliness of this website and provide services that would not be possible without cookies.

The user of a website that uses cookies does not have to enter the access data again with each visit as this is done by the website and the cookie stored on the user's computer system.

By changing the setting of the respective Internet browser, the setting of cookies for all Internet pages can be prevented. Already set cookies can be deleted again.

This is possible with all common Internet browsers. If the user deactivates the setting of cookies in the used Internet browser, not all functions of the website may be fully usable.

## **Server Log Files**

The provider of the pages automatically collects and stores information in so-called server log files, which your browser automatically transmits to us.

These are:

- browser type and browser version
- operating system used
- referrer URL
- host name of the accessing computer
- time of server request
- IP address

A combination of data with other sources is not made.

## **ecomas® CMS Analysis**

Our website uses the analysis service of ecomas-CMS. The provider is: concept-computer GmbH, Zehnerstr. 73, 53498 Bad Breisig, Germany.

From the data, usage profiles can be created under a pseudonym.

Cookies can be used for this purpose. Cookies are small text files stored locally in the cache of your Internet browser. The cookies make it possible to recognize your browser. The data collected by ecomas CMS analysis technologies will not be used to personally identify visitors to our website without the explicit consent of the person concerned and will not be merged with personal data about the bearer of the pseudonym.

ecomas CMS analysis cookies remain on your device until you delete them.

The storage of ecomas CMS analysis cookies is based on Art. 6 GDPR.

The website operator has a legitimate interest in the anonymized analysis of user behavior in order to optimize both the advertising offer and the advertising.

You can object to data collection and storage at any time with effect for the future.

By deactivating this check box (from on to off) you can set an opt-out cookie in order to disagree with data collection and storage of your visitor data for the future.

In this way, an opt-out cookie named “ecomasAcookie” is set by ecomas CMS analysis. Please do not delete this cookie as long as you want to maintain your opposition.

## **Conclusion of a Data Processing Contract**

We have concluded a data processing contract with “cocept-computer GmbH” (creator of ecomas CMS and fully implement the strict requirements of the German data protection authorities when using ecomas CMS analysis.

## **Purpose of Data Collection**

Personal data will only be collected by us if you provide us with the data, for example, in the case of contacting us. The input of data takes place in the following sectors:

### **Contact Form**

The contact form offers interested parties the opportunity to send inquiries directly to Moog Rekofa GmbH. Due to legal regulations our website also contains information (e.g. in the imprint) which allows a quick electronic contact with our company (e.g. via e-mail address). If a person contacts the company via e-mail or contact form, the personal data transmitted by the person will be automatically saved. Such voluntarily transmitted data is stored only for processing or contacting the responsible person. There is no transmission of personal data to third parties.

### **Mail Contact**

If a person contacts us by e-mail, the data transmitted in form of the e-mail is automatically saved in an audit-proof manner and archived. (Exception: applicant mails to: [bewerbung@moog.rekofa.com](mailto:bewerbung@moog.rekofa.com)) Data submitted during this context will be stored for the purpose of processing or contacting the person.

Unless required for the purpose of processing, there is no disclosure of this personal data to third parties outside the company.

## **Legal Basis of Data Processing**

Art. 6 GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) serves as a legal basis for processing operations where we need to obtain consent for a particular processing purpose. If the processing of personal data is necessary for the performance of a contract of which the person concerned is the contracting party, as is the case, e.g. in processing operations necessary for the supply of goods or in providing any other service or consideration, processing shall be based on Art. 6 GDPR. The same applies to processing operations that are necessary to carry out pre-contractual measures, e.g. in cases of inquiries concerning our products or services. If our company is subject to a legal obligation which requires the processing of personal data, such as the fulfillment of tax obligations, the processing is based on Art. 6 GDPR.

If processing of personal data is not based on any of the aforementioned legal bases, we process data to safeguard the legitimate interests of our company (improvement of the operation of the business).

In doing so, we always ensure that no interest worthy of protection, which outweighs our legitimate interest, is contrary to this.

### **Duration for which the Personal Data is stored**

The respective statutory retention period is the criterion for the duration of the storage of personal data. After the deadline, all corresponding data will be routinely deleted if they are no longer required to fulfill the contract or to initiate a contract.

### **Right of Information and Cancellation, Right of Appeal, Right to Data Portability, Limitation of Processing, Rectification and Deletion**

Each user has the right to obtain information about the data we have stored and about the purpose of the storage at any time. Each user can revoke the consent to the storage or use of personal data in writing at any time.

In addition to the revocation, you have the right to request the correction as well as the restriction of the processing and blocking or deletion of your data.

You have the right to apply for complaints to the appropriate supervisory authority (for NRW: the country commissioner for data protection and freedom of information North Rhine Westphalia in Düsseldorf).

You also have the right to receive the data you submit in a machine-readable format for transmission.

If there are any questions concerning the processing of personal data, you may also contact us directly (responsible office: see imprint). For all questions and requests for information, any other requests or complaints, you may also contact our external data protection officers directly.

### **IT-Safety**

Moog Rekofa GmbH uses technical and organizational security measures to protect your provided personal data from accidental or intentional manipulation, loss, destruction or access by unauthorized persons.

Our security measures are constantly being improved in line with technological development.
